Student Screening for LCS

Does your child have allergy symptoms right now?

Alert the Principal so he can make everyone aware their symptoms are not contagious. They will be helped to practice safe hygiene measures inside the school.

Is your child experiencing: severe breathing difficulty, severe chest pain, difficulty waking up, or are they losing consciousness?

Your child will not be permitted entry to LCS. These symptoms require immediate attention. Call 911 immediately or go directly to your nearest emergency department and have your child assessed for a COVID-19 test.

Is your child experiencing: mild to moderate shortness of breath, inability to lie down because of difficulty breathing or chronic health conditions that you are having difficulty managing because of difficulty with breathing?

Your child will not be permitted entry to LCS. Please consult your family doctor or nurse practitioner, or call 811.

Is your child experiencing cold, flu or COVID-19 like symptoms, even mildly? Symptoms include: fever, chills, cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, painful swallowing, stuffy or runny nose, loss of smell, headache, muscle aches, fatigue or loss of appetite.

Your child will not be permitted entry to LCS. Please consult your family doctor or nurse practitioner, or call 811. If it is determined that they do not have COVID-19, they may return to school once symptoms resolve.

Has your child traveled to any countries outside Canada or even visited an airport within the last 14 days?
